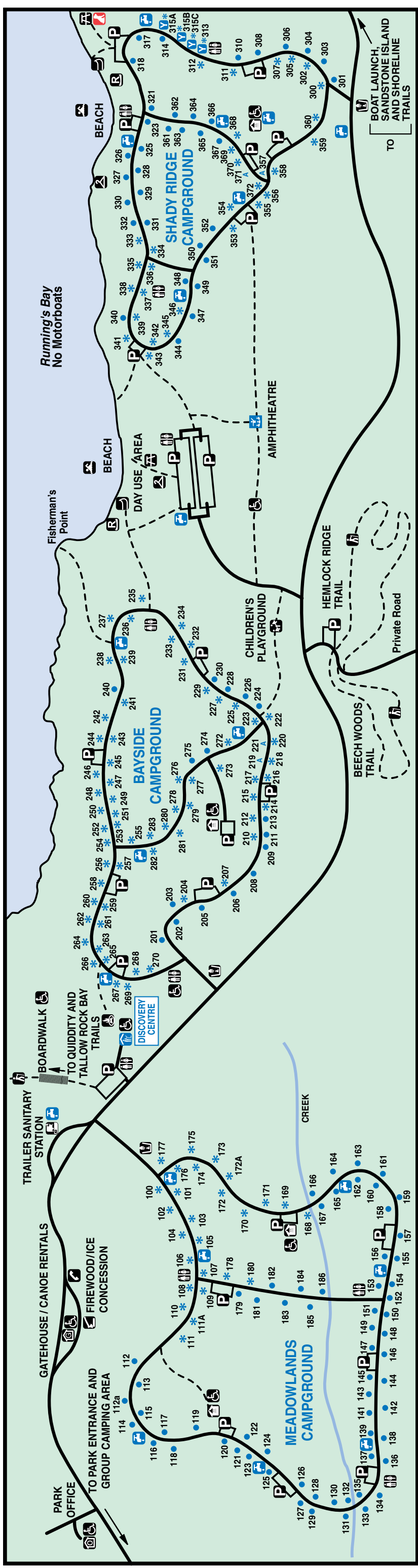

Hiking Trails at the Park

Trail	Length (return)	Difficulty Level	Features
Sandstone Island	2.6 km	moderate	Rare rockshelter; unique geological features; scenic lookout
Shoreline	2.0 km	moderate	Scenic views of the rugged Charleston Lake shoreline
Beech Woods	1.8 km	easy	Quiet & tranquil
Hemlock Ridge	1.7 km	moderate	Pass through rock crevices; large hemlock & pine trees
Quiddity	2.4 km	easy	Cross a boardwalk over a wetland; scenic lookout
Tallow Rock Bay	10 km	difficult	Scenic lookouts; remote areas of the park
Blue Mountain From Huckleberry Hollow	5.7 km	difficult	Scenic vista (highest point in the park); mature forest with large oak & pine trees; <i>trail access by water only</i>
